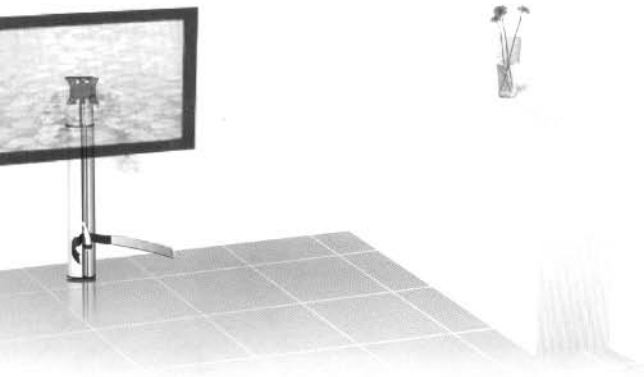

GUARANTEE TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. We guarantee that if during the guarantee period of a product, faults arise due to defects in manufacturing and/or materials, it will, at its discretion, repair or if necessary replace the product, free of cost. A guarantee for normal wear and tear is hereby expressly excluded.
2. If the guarantee is invoked, the product should be sent to us together with the original purchase document (invoice, sales slip or cash receipt). The purchase document should clearly show the name of the supplier and the date of purchase.
3. Our guarantee shall lapse in the following cases:
 - If the product has not been drilled, installed and used in accordance with the instruction for use;
 - If the product has been altered or repaired by someone a party other than us;
 - If a fault arises due to external causes (outside the product) such as for example lightning, water nuisance, fire, scuffing, exposure to extreme temperatures, weather conditions, solvents or acids, wrong use or negligence;
 - If the product is used for different equipment than is mentioned on or in the packing.

Warning

Correct installation is extremely essential, and falls outside the scope of responsibility of us. The fastening material provided is exclusively intended for installation on walls made of solid wood, bricks, concrete or solid-wood columns with a maximum of 3 mm wall finishing. For walls made of other materials, for example hollow bricks, please consult your installer and/or specialist supplier.

Maximum load per Audio/DVD support LEA8238 = 10KG/22lbs. Maximum 3 Audio/DVD supports LEA8238 per column system LEA8103.

During installation, please also follow the instructions for installation and use of the apparatus to be installed/ fixed (for example the LCD/plasma screen).

Installation advice

If you are using a modular system (Audio/DVD support LEA8103 and/or column system LEA8238), it is important to start measuring and installing from the floor (or skirting board) upwards.
